Building Report:

Demolition sits at around 85%, with the only areas left to be removed in the ladies locker room and surrounding areas. This work is scheduled for next week.

The new roof over the majority of the building will be completed this week, weather permitting. The original steel trusses over the main room have been repaired with an angle iron welded to the trusses for further strength.

Carpet choices are almost complete and we hope to have this finalised by the end of this week. Thank you to the Members who are helping with this process. We hope to gather \$15000 of savings from the Carpet insurance to be used elsewhere in the building.

The internal layout has been modified to allow for a building that can cater for functions up to 200 people and at the same time provide spaces for the enjoyment of members. We are achieving this by extending the bar south to provide more service area for functions. The Pro Shop will move eastward to the area previously used as club storage and workshop and the existing Pro Shop area will become a Members' Lounge.

The Spike bar will see the removal of a central column to open the area up and will be enlarged by moving the East wall in to the Men's locker room. Provision has been made for future conversion of the Men's toilets

I know that several people, including myself, have not donated as yet and if you have indicated you are going to donate then now is the time to do so.

I am confident that we can raise the necessary funds to complete the works and look forward to the Club House reopening on schedule in early August.
