ONE SIZE DOES NOT FIT ALL

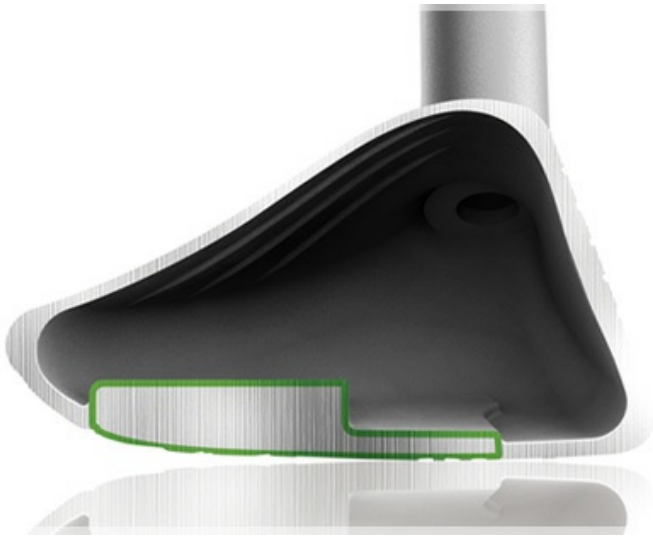
Here's some trivia for you; does an 18° Hybrid do the same job as an 18° Fairway Wood?

The answer of course is "No" (scroll down further in the newsletter and you'll see we conducted a test to prove it) but that hasn't stopped many golfers taking Fairways out of their bags, replacing them 'like for like' with those easy to hit Hybrids. This set 'self medication' is a problem, and here are five very good reasons why:

1. Hybrid designs are 'easier to hit' than long Irons, not Fairways (they just have shorter shafts).
2. There is absolutely no industry standard dictating what loft any number Hybrid should have.
3. There aren't any standards dictating what lofts Fairway Woods should have either!
4. A correct Hybrid swing is more 'descending', whereas a Fairway Wood swing is more 'sweeping'.
5. Even with identical swings, design variances between Fairways & Hybrids deliver completely different results

These are two very different clubs, designed for different swings, to do different jobs. Now combine the two properly and you have a 'go-to' club for every lie, every scenario, and every distance; all you need to do is make the swing!

"Why can't I do it myself?" you ask... Take a look at the image below.



HYBRID OR FAIRWAY?

As design boundaries become increasingly blurred, so it becomes more difficult to separate Hybrids from Fairways; but you have to if you want to make meaningful improvements in your long game.
